

Simple Hummus

1 x 400g tin chickpeas

1 small glove garlic

1 tbsp tahini

1 lemon

Extra virgin olive oil

Salt

Method

Drain chickpeas and tip into a food processor.

Peel and add garlic, tahini, lemon juice, 1 tbsp olive oil, and a pinch of salt.

Blitz until smooth, scraping down the sides as needed.

Add more lemon juice/cold water to taste.

Serve with sliced crunchy veg, crackers, or toasted flatbreads.
